**Resolution 09-09**

**A Resolution of the Board of Commissioners of Ronald Wastewater District  
Establishing a Temporary “Aurora Corridor Phase Two Utilities Relocation  
Surcharge.”**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners did establish with Resolution 98-52 a policy to annually review surcharges and paragraph two of Resolution 98-52 states, “The Board of Commissioners has now determined that is should investigate the propriety of establishing uniform rates throughout the District and the future elimination of surcharges unless there is substantial need for a surcharge required by Bond Covenants, Contract, Statute or Operational Requirements in any existing or future Utility Local Improvement District or geographical area of the District”; and

WHEREAS, the District’s Franchise contract with the City of Shoreline requires that, should the City widen a right-of-way and the District’s facilities must be relocated, and if the relocation occurs more than five years after the facilities were initially constructed, then relocation shall be at the District’s sole cost; and

WHEREAS, the District has been informed by the City that it shall undertake the widening of Aurora Ave N as part of its Aurora Corridor Phase Two Widening Project and that some District mainlines must be relocated; and

WHEREAS, the engineers cost estimate for the relocation of the sanitary sewer main lines is \$300,000; and

WHEREAS, there are 15,844 residential accounts that result in the billing of 16,292 units, some of the residential accounts being duplexes, triplexes, and fourplexes; and

WHEREAS, there are 719 commercial accounts that result in the billing of 9,653 units; and

WHEREAS, the total number of billing units is 25,945 and that the project cost of \$300,000 should be divided among these billing units which will result in a cost of approximately \$12.00 for each billing unit; and

WHEREAS, the Board determines that this cost should be born by all the users of the sanitary collection system and should be collected over the course of twelve months to pay for the relocation costs.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Ronald Wastewater District that an “Aurora Corridor Phase Two Utilities Relocation Surcharge” be established.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that starting with the August 2009 billing period this surcharge shall be collected as follows:

Single Family Residence:	\$2.00 each billing cycle (\$1.00 per month per unit).
Duplex:	\$4.00 each billing cycle (\$1.00 per month per unit).
Triplex:	\$6.00 each billing cycle (\$1.00 per month per unit).
Fourplex:	\$8.00 each billing cycle (\$1.00 per month per unit).
Commercial:	\$1.00 per RCE per month, either the actual unit count of based on water consumption, which ever is higher.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this amount shall be collected monthly until sufficient funds have been collected to pay all relocation expenses, and then the surcharge will cease.
